ABSTRACT GUIDLINES:


- 1.Post-graduates, senior residents and faculties who have registered for the conference are eligible to present research papers/ case series/ rare or unusual cases.
- 2. Registration for the conference is mandatory for Abstract Submission.
- 3.Each member will be allowed to present either one paper or poster (and not both).
- 4.All the abstracts should be uploaded to the conference website after online registration. Hard copies or CDs sent by post will not be accepted.
- 5. The last date for abstract submission is 25th Jan 2023. No abstracts will be accepted after this deadline.
- 6. The abstract should contain the following details:
 - a.Name of the presenting author and co-authors
 - b.Designation and Institute Affiliation
 - c.Delegate's registration number of the presenting author
 - d. Address for correspondence
 - e.Mobile number and Email ID
 - f. The appropriate sub-speciality: The delegates may choose the following sub-speciality Anemia, Leukaemia/ Lymphoma, Bleeding and Coagulation disorders, Hematopathology/ Laboratory Hematology, Clinical Hematology, Transplantation, Transfusion Medicine, Bone marrow pathology, Lymph node pathology, and Others.
- 7. The maximum word limit for an abstract is 300 words. The abstract should be in Times New Roman font with the size of 12pt
- 8. The abstract should include an Introduction/ Background, Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions, and Keywords. A maximum of one table & figure is allowed.
- 9. Grammatical errors and spelling mistakes must be corrected before submission.
- All abstracts will be peer-reviewed, and the committee reserves the right to assign them as oral papers or poster presentations. Correspondence regarding a change in the presentation shall not be entertained.
